



Rules of Play

- In order to be eligible for prizes, **women** should tee off from the **Oak tees (gold)** and **men** from the **Cinnabar tees (red)**.
- **Today's format is a Scramble.** Each person in your group will drive on every hole. You then select the drive you prefer to play and place all balls within one-club length of the ball selected (no closer to the hole). You continue with this procedure until the ball is holed out. Once you arrive on the green, you must place the ball within 6" of the ball selected. If you elect to play a ball from a hazard, you may still improve your lie one-club length, but it must remain in the hazard.
- **The highest score on any hole is Bogey.** Please pick up once the team cannot do any better.
- There is a **minimum of two (2) drives per player** used over the 18 holes played.
- Green staked/environmentally sensitive areas are played as lateral water hazards.

Games on the Course

- **Hole in One** – Keep a look out for Hole in One prizes you can win at various locations on the course. Hole in One prizes are generously provided by **Moore Buick/Pontiac/GMC Truck in Los Gatos** and **Magnussen Lexus of Fremont**.
