## **Sobrato Family Foundation Awards \$149,650 Multi-Year Challenge Grant to Hospice of the Valley**

### ***2:1 challenge grant to match new and increased cash donations to Hospice of the Valley***

**SAN JOSE, Calif., Feb. 23, 2015** – The Sobrato Family Foundation has awarded a \$149,650 multi-year 2:1 challenge grant to Hospice of the Valley, a leading provider in palliative and hospice care, grief counseling and education in Northern California.

For every dollar raised for Hospice of the Valley, the Sobrato Family Foundation will match it times two, up to \$149,650.

The first year's unconditional grant is \$73,000 and the second year's conditional grant is \$76,650. The Sobrato Family Foundation's 2:1 Challenge Grant is contingent on new or increased donations during the grant fundraising period.
